The Approach

What was the scope of their involvement?

For a third-party client, they worked with us on a large e-commerce build that leveraged headless implementation. We decoupled the frontend presentation layout from the e-commerce experience, so we used several of their team members for the project.

They essentially became a part of our team in the process. We codeveloped the million-dollar implementation that supported 20 different currencies and locations for sites around the world. Their developers had experience with React.js, which we were using to create the frontend experience.

What is the team composition?

We worked with a solutions architect as well as several frontend developers and QA testers. Their solutions architect collaborated with our solutions architect to design the solution together.

How did you come to work with Hatimeria?

One of our technical leads worked with them prior to joining our organization. When we needed extra developers, he recommended their team to us. Our first project with them was a smaller project. As more projects came in, we began leveraging their various resources.
